Sometimes you're okay doing without what you wish for. Sometimes projects take a while to be figured out. And sometimes, you have to tell yourself: "Let's Make it Happen!" ... and then just go ahead and do it yourself!

So, here it is - the first edition of a Resource Guide for Sneads Ferry - the kind I wish I had during my relocation process.

What I've learned about my new stomping grounds is:

The post office knows Sneads Ferry as 28460. We are a Waterside Community, an Unincorporated Village ... in the County of Onslow ... and a part of the Stump Sound Township ... on the south end of the Crystal Coast of North Carolina. As such we have no "mayor" or town governance. Instead it is a "live and let live" environment where neighbors handle their relationships one-on-

one amongst themselves while keeping an eye on the County Government's decisions as they pertain the province.

The Sneads Ferry village and surrounding community is one of the fastest growing areas within Onslow County. Because of that there are a few things to consider:

- Roads (traditionally congested in the summer) may require your patience - year round.
- Temporary buildings are to be expected for students because all schools are at capacity.
- Public safety services partner with one another and the military to provide service for the quickly growing citizenship.

What I have discovered is that whatever you want from the quaint to the contemporary is right here. It might take you a little while to find what you're looking for ... but it's here.

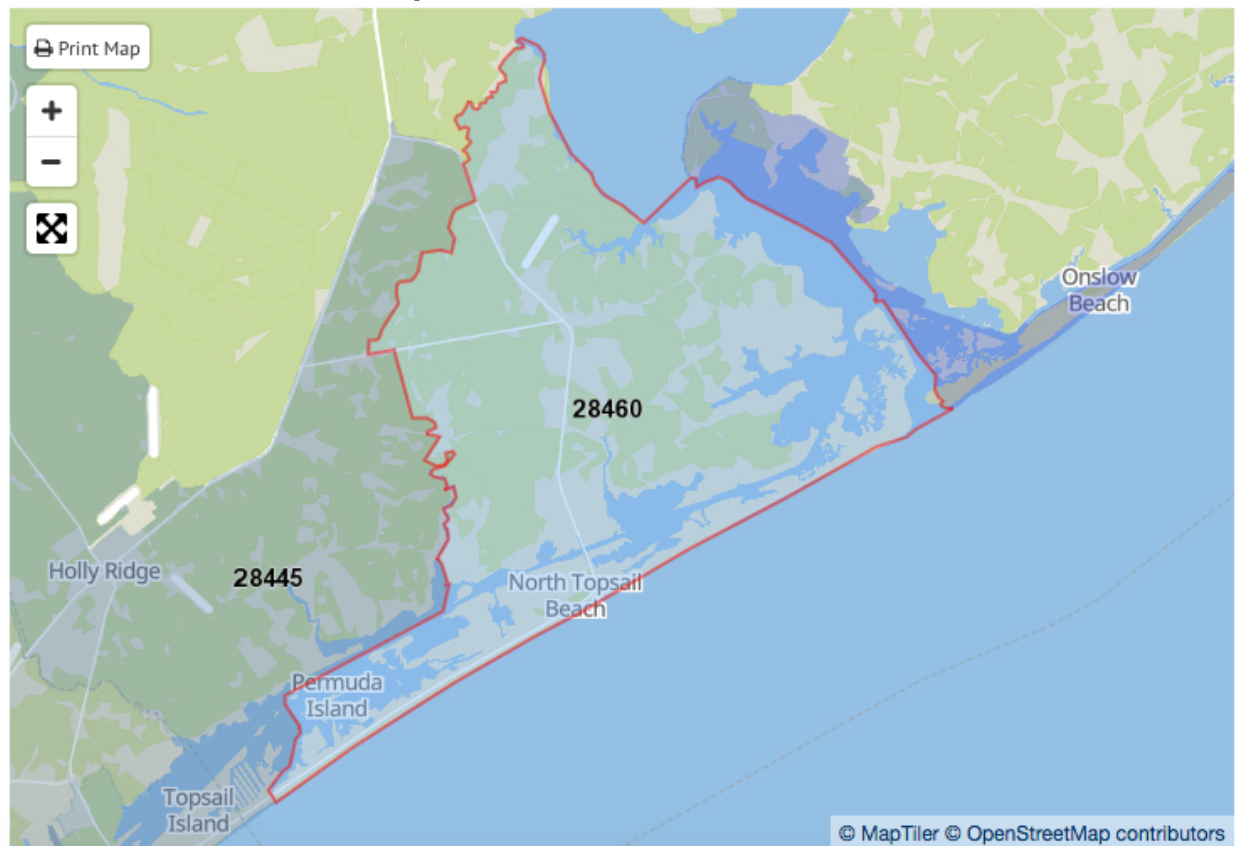
AREA MAPS

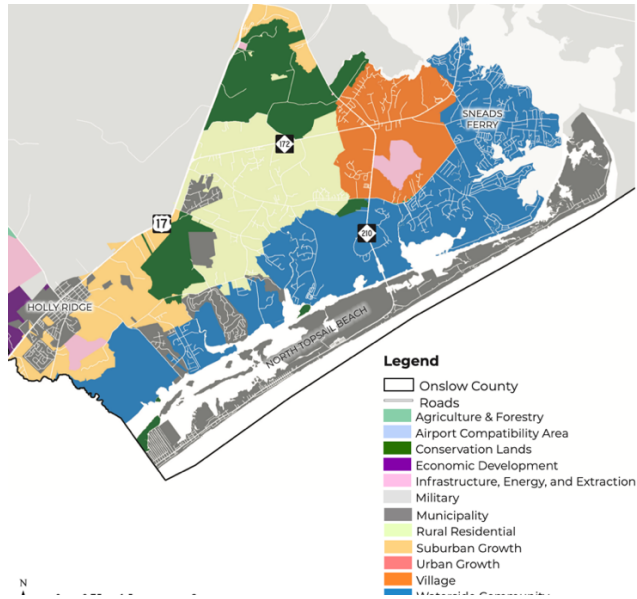
As time has gone by and the area has grown ... lines and boundaries have gotten blurred. Here are some maps to help you get your bearings.

The post office knows us as 28460.

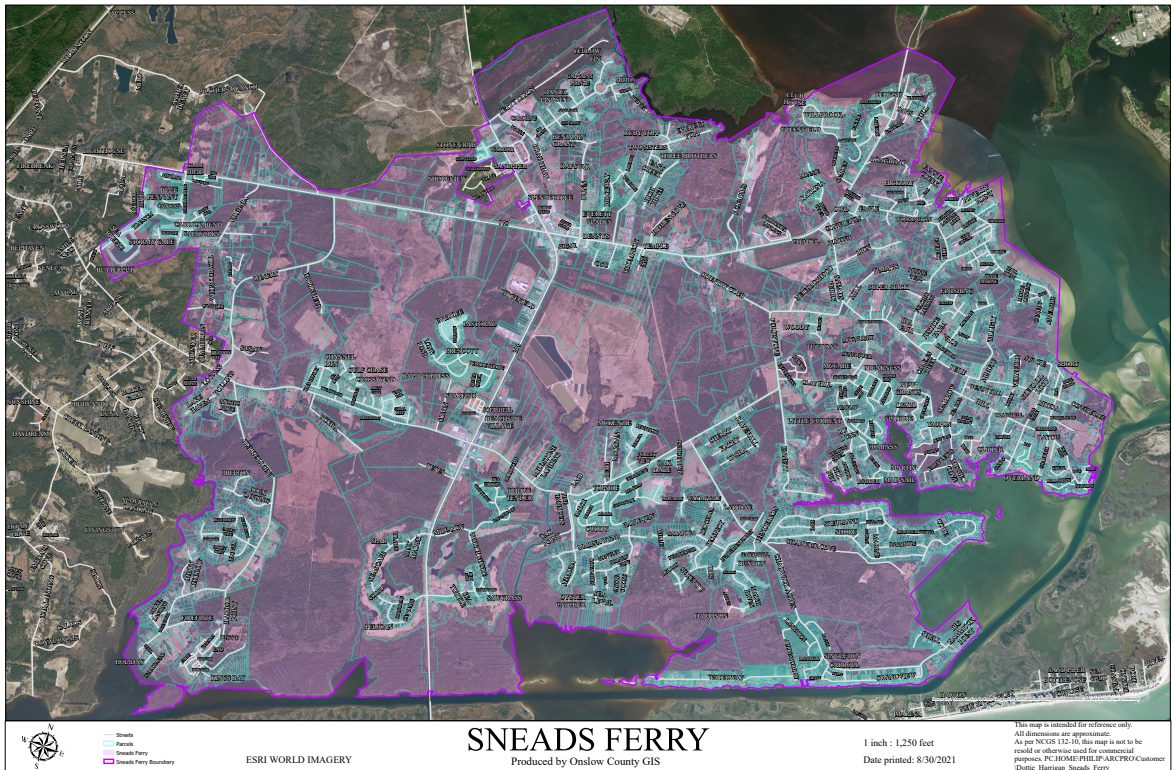

As per the County description - We are a Waterside Community ...



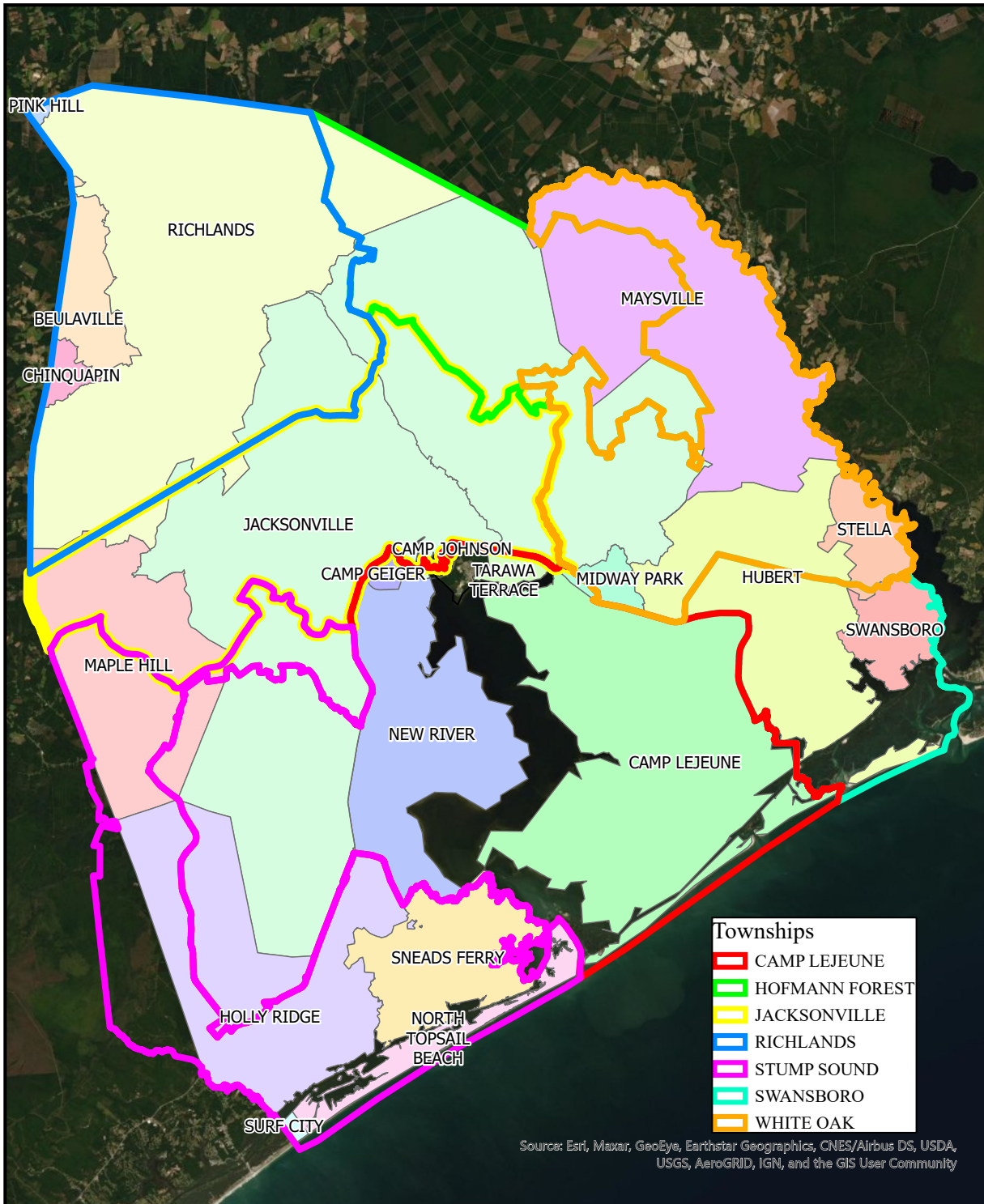

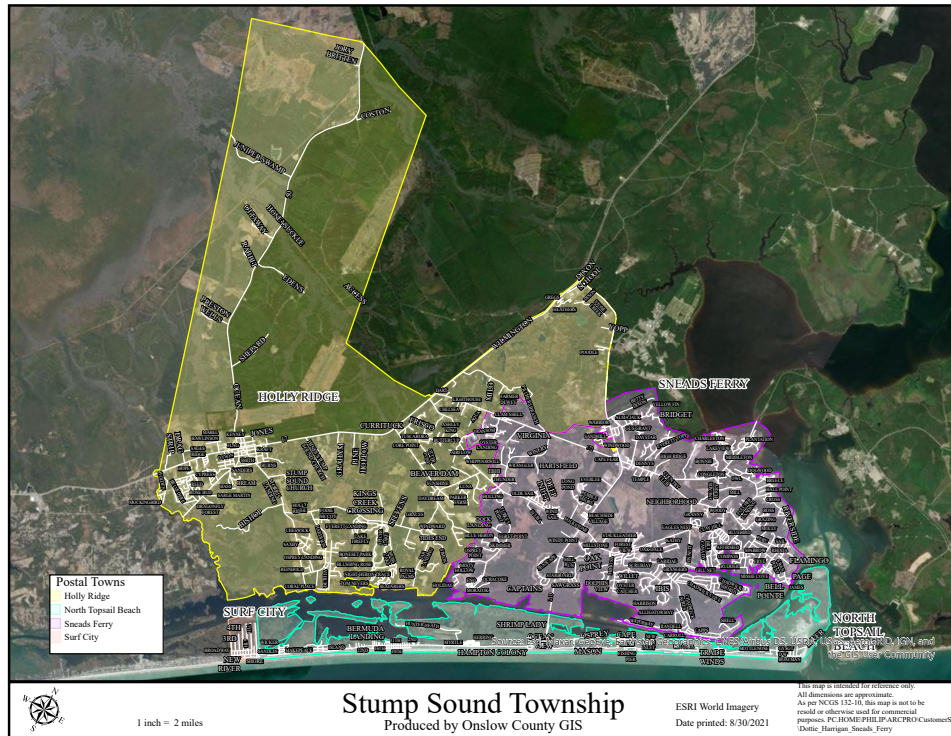

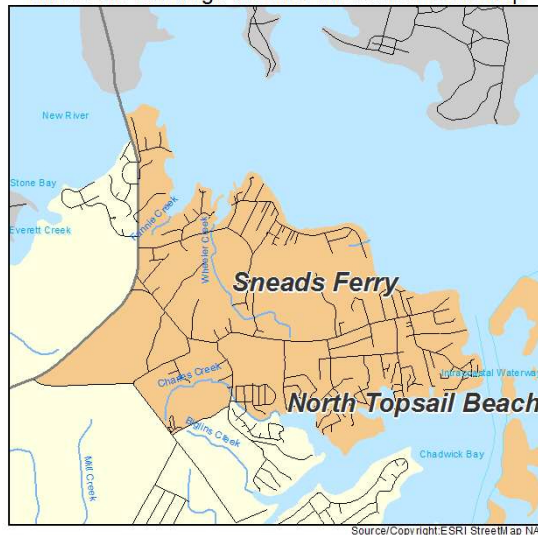

Where to Live in 28460

Sneads Ferry offers a variety of housing choices—from affordable family-oriented neighborhoods to upscale gated waterfront communities. A rough estimate of the housing mix is 70% single family homes, 20% town homes, 10% mobile homes and small apartments. Below are some of the neighborhoods within the 28460 postal zip code.

Because Sneads Ferry is in Onslow county - one of the fastest growing counties in North Carolina - and has an active waterfront culture with boating, fishing charters, and marinas - the housing market is changing rapidly. ANNUAL EVENTS

Many small towns have their customs and traditions and Sneads ferry is no different. There are several events that local residents and visitors look forward to every year.

King Mackerel Tournament

Recreational fishermen come from near and far to compete in the Sneads Ferry Rotary's King Mackerel Tournament. 2025 marks their 34th year hosting the event.

Blessing of the Fleet

To honor the fisher men and women of the past, celebrate the heritage of shrimp industry in Sneads Ferry, and to pray for a safe and bountiful shrimping season the community comes together for the annual Blessing of the Fleet.

Organized and hosted by Davis Seafood at the opening of shrimp season the event welcomes the community with a service conducted by a collaboration of Sneads Ferry ministers from various churches who offer prayer, the reading of scripture, and hymns.

Shrimp boats from all the Sneads Ferry fish houses gather in the New River and circle round for the Laying of the Wreath & Rememberance, the Receiving of Prayer & Blessing of the Fleet, followed by the Boat Procession. It's quite a sight and can be fully enjoyed from the Davis Seafood dock. The processional can be viewed from many other fish house docks or private homes along the New River between the 172 back gate bridge and the intercoastal waterway.

Shrimp Festival

2025 marks the 54th annual Sneads Ferry Shrimp Festival also known as the North Carolina Shrimp Festival produced by the Sneads Ferry Community Council. The multiple day event includes a Scholarship Pageant for Shrimp Festival Queen's Court, a Gala celebrating the "Fisherman of the Year", a Parade along the riverfront, and the main Festival which includes food trucks, crafters, rides, attractions, and the Shrimp-A-roo (shrimp dinner). It is held at the Sneads Ferry Community Center, 126 Park Lane.

Christmas in the Ferry

The Sneads Ferry Community Council holds its annual Christmas in the Ferry on a Friday and Saturday early in December. It's a little different every year but is entirely focused on kids activities and generally includes food, games, entertainment, prizes, gifts and lots of Christmas decorations. Breakfast with Santa and the Festival of Trees are two highlights of the event.

Many local businesses and organizations have their own re-occurring or annual events that are not so widely advertised. Once you're here you'll discover so many more things to do in and around the province.

SPECIAL CHARACTERISTICS

The Merging of Quaint & Contemporary in a Changing World

I hesitate to describe Sneads Ferry because it is changing so quickly these words will surely be different by the time you read them - but here goes an attempt for your general understanding.

Old & New

It's a province of old and new. When I first met our Fire Chief and told him where I live he exclaimed "Oh! You live in OLD SNEADS FERRY! with a smile on his face - like I had made it to the real part of town. I don't really know how to explain it but there is a difference in the old and the new.

Generally ... Sneads Ferry sits to the east of US Highway 17 and is connected by Rt. 172 and Rt. 210.

"Old" Sneads Ferry is tucked off of Highway 172 from the south gate of Camp Lejeune and off of Wheeler Creek Road, Sneads Ferry Road. In the past the hub of Sneads Ferry was the intersection of Sneads Ferry Road and Old Folkstone Road.

"New" Sneads Ferry are the commercial and residential communities springing up along the intersections of Rt. 172 & Rt. 210 and the intersection of Rt. 210 & Old Folkstone Road.

To get a feel for "Old Sneads Ferry" its beginning and its history visit the Sneads Ferry Library and check out "*Images of America, Sneads Ferry*" by Sherry W. Thurston and Joshua W. Thurston with a Foreword by Sadie Rouse Sanders Duke (Arcadia Publishing copyright 2011). The Introduction reads as history any heritage family living here now can attest to its validity. It includes Historical Beginnings, Families, Churches, Homesteads, Commerce, Wartime, and Education specific to Sneads Ferry.

Interestingly the Acknowledgements page lists family names that are recognizable in "New Sneads Ferry" as street names and residential communities. And it mentions the history and the beginning of the annual Sneads Ferry Shrimp Festival, also known as the North Carolina Shrimp Festival, currently in its 54th season.

Demographics

This is not the official demographics but what I have noticed from living here for several years is that there are people of all ages

- Heritage Families - those who have called it home for generations
- Transplants & Retirees - those wanting to make a change in their lifestyle for various reasons including ex-military who were stationed here and have come back "home"
- Military - those stationed here shortterm or whose spouses have decided to call it home longterm

Seasons: Winter is short but can be harsh for "snow birds". Spring is beautiful and comes early. The height of Summer can be blistering hot and humid and usually ends with a stormy season. Fall offers crisp mornings and warm afternoons and is full of autumn fairs and harvest festivities.

Special Personality

It gets quiet here in the winter. Because of the beach, traffic is "bad" in the summer. There are pop-up markets at least nine months out of the year. Food Trucks abound.

Due to the growth you'll notice lots of shifting and changing of retail stores and service providers as they scale up into larger spaces or diversify into multiple smaller spaces, or restructure into a blend of home base, retail and/or commercial space as needed.

Seafood: The freshness can't be beat and supplies abound with oysters, crabs, fish, and shrimp all available seasonally - often the same day of harvest - from local fishermen who sell through various markets around the province. This is really something to be celebrated, honored, and supported as fishermen

struggle to protect their livelihoods and service to the community against emerging markets and political trends.

Agriculture: Within Sneads Ferry and just a little west of us are beautiful farms that produce fruits, vegetables, berries, grains, and proteins that are available throughout the year through farmers markets, seafood markets and even the grocery store.

Recreation: Activities generally center around the water - boating, sailing, fishing, kayaking, surfing, and beaching. But there is a lively county recreation department for all ages and there are private sports leagues, clubs and organizations for kids.

There's a lot to discover, celebrate and honor by living in Sneads Ferry. Venture out and enjoy exploring both the old and the new of the province.
